Dear RFR Coordinator,

Thank you for serving as the coordinator for the Retirement Fund for Religious (RFR) collection in your (arch)diocese. As we approach the 2017 appeal, I respectfully request your assistance in helping raise awareness about the ongoing needs of our elderly religious.

The national collection is scheduled for December 9–10, 2017, although your (arch)diocese may have scheduled the collection for an alternate weekend. Printed parish materials are shipped approximately four to eight weeks prior to the collection date recorded for your (arch)diocese in the National Collections database. Samples of these items are enclosed.

In response to feedback from several coordinators, we have developed two short notices to facilitate easier communication with clergy and staff. (*See page 4.*) We have also created a social media tool kit with text and photos that can be used to promote the appeal on Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter. These and all our other downloadable resources will be available after September 1 at retiredreligious.org. We understand you may not have time to make use of every resource, but utilizing even one or two can have a significant impact on collection totals. The most important step is to urge pastors to announce the collection from the pulpit.

(Arch)bishops will receive a one-page resource letter that is sent electronically. The letter offers links to various promotional materials, including text for a Bishop to Parishioner letter in support of the collection. (*See page 3*.)



Simple Steps for Promoting the Retirement Fund for Religious (RFR)

Although you may not have the time or resources to complete every step, undertaking even one or two of the suggestions below can positively impact donations.

Publicize the collection using posters, bulletin/pulpit announcements, press releases, advertisements, and/or social media. *Visit retiredreligious.org/materials to download.*

Distribute a letter from the (arch)bishop to parishioners in support of the RFR. *See sample text, page 3.*

Encourage pastors to announce the collection from the pulpit. If possible, organize speakers to make the RFR appeal in parishes.

Thank all who supported the RFR. Ask parishes to use the bulletin announcement for the week following the appeal to acknowledge donations.

Sample Letter: (Arch)bishops to Parishioners (English and Spanish)

Dear Friends in Christ,

Soon, our parishes will be conducting the appeal for the Retirement Fund for Religious, an annual collection that benefits more than 32,000 elderly Catholic sisters, brothers, and religious order priests.

Our senior religious are a treasure. Their dedication and hard work laid the foundation for Catholic schools, hospitals, and numerous social service organizations. Many continue in volunteer ministry today. Their ongoing prayer and witness enrich our faith in countless ways. I am grateful for the service of religious, past and present. I hope you, too, recall a sister or brother who made a positive difference in your life.

Most elder religious worked for years for small stipends, leaving a substantial gap in retirement savings. Rising health-care costs and decreased income compound the challenge to meet such day-to-day needs as medications and nursing assistance. The Retirement Fund for Religious offers financial support that helps religious communities provide loving care for older members while ensuring younger ones can continue the good works of their elders.

I understand you are asked to support many worthy causes. I invite you only to give what you can. Most importantly, please pray for God's continued blessing on all our women and men religious. Rest assured they are praying for you!
