


Meet Sister Lucille

“I had no other desire than to be a nun,” says Sister Mary Lucille Stelly, 89, who knew early on that she would pursue religious life. A member of the Sisters of the Holy Family in New Orleans, she taught in Catholic schools and later ministered in nursing homes—remaining in active ministry until her eighties.

Today, she lives in her congregational motherhouse. There, she is sustained by a shared commitment to prayer, service, and community.

Like Sister Lucille, most older religious served for little or no pay. Today, many US religious orders lack adequate retirement savings. 
